Day 2 **BUENOS AIRES**

On arrival in Buenos Aires, we are met by our local guide and transferred to our hotel where we settle in and relax. This evening, join us for a casual welcome dinner.

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Day 3 ESTANCIA EL OMBÚ DE ARECO

We depart the city to journey into the fabulous hinterlands of Argentina, where we will visit El Ombú de Areco, a historic Estancia (ranch) just 120 km from Buenos Aires. Established in 1880, this magnificent property has been owned by the Boelcke family since 1934. Upon arrival, we're greeted with delicious empanadas. Take time to explore the property on foot or by carriage ride before indulging in an "asado criollo" BBQ lunch, followed by a folk music show and an authentic private cooking demonstration.

After our day at the Estancia, we return to the city and our hotel for a wonderful evening. Enjoy dinner and a Tango Show at a traditional Argentinean 'Asados'. Our very intimate setting boasts two centuries of history and culture for a stunning display of emotion and physical prowess.

Day 4 BUENOS AIRES, THE "PARIS OF SOUTH AMERICA"

Today, Buenos Aires is at your fingertips as our local guide leads us on an informative tour through the heart of the city. We board our private coach and begin at Plaza de Mayo, home to the Government House, City Hall, and the Metropolitan Cathedral. We then journey through San Telmo, known as the Tango District, before arriving at La Boca, where colorful and picturesque houses line Caminito Street. La Boca, the oldest harbor in Buenos Aires, holds historical significance as the arrival point for many Italian immigrants in the 19th century.

Next, we head north to Recoleta, the city's most elegant district, characterized by wide avenues, lovely parks, and magnificent residences. Here, we'll visit the monumental cemetery, the resting place of Evita Perón and other historical figures. After lunch at a local restaurant, we transfer to the pier to board the Oosterdam, our home for the next 15 nights.

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Day 5 TIGRE DELTA

Today, we venture to Tigre, a picturesque town located 30 km from Buenos Aires, nestled on the Delta of Paraná River. As we drive north, we'll pass through the elegant neighborhoods of Olivos, Martinez, and San Isidro. Take a short break at the main square of San Isidro to admire the beautiful neogothic cathedral. Continuing our journey, we arrive in Tigre and board a river boat for a scenic 60-minute tour. Along the way, we'll see unique weekend houses only accessible by water, giving us a glimpse of life on the delta. Although we'll explore just a small part of the vast Paraná Delta, spanning over 300 km north, we'll witness the area's year-round temperate microclimate, which supports the growth of special trees and flowers. After our boat ride, we'll return to Buenos Aires via the highway, concluding our day of exploration in the heart of nature.

Day 6 MONTEVIDEO, URUGUAY

Montevideo is renowned for its leisurely pace, with long lunches, siestas, and elegant high tea rituals. This modern metropolis also boasts a historical old town dating back to colonial times and is surrounded by an uninterrupted stretch of white sandy beaches. Our tour today takes us deep into the history and culture of this region.

Included Private Shore Excursion – Montevideo



Explore Montevideo's monuments, parks, and gardens, including highlights such as the Old City, Constitution Square, Cathedral, and Colonial Town Hall. Visit the iconic Solis Theatre and Independence Square, where you'll find the monument dedicated to the national hero, José Gervasio Artigas, and his Mausoleum. Marvel at the grandeur of the Congress Building, boasting 52 colors of local marble and 12 types of wood, which remains the pride of Uruguay.

Venture to the Prado neighborhood and one of the city's oldest parks, home to the famous sculpture "La Diligencia" (The Stage Coach), a monument to the last Charruas Indians. Conclude your tour at Plaza Virgilio, where you'll discover a spectacular view of the city before following the coast and magnificent beaches back to the ship.

Day 7 & 8 DAYS AT SEA

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Day 9 PORT STANLEY, FALKLAND ISLANDS

The Falkland Islands were visited by Charles Darwin in the 19th century and, like the Galapagos, were found to contain examples of flora and fauna not seen elsewhere. These discoveries prompted thoughts in Darwin, which found shape in his iconoclastic work, 'Origin of Species.' Some of these discoveries, like the Warrah, the once common Falkland Islands fox, have now disappeared, but others remain. These include birds such as the Cobbs wren, plants such as the colourful Felton's flower, Falkland's false plantain and an inhabitant of the unique geological stone runs, the fascinating snake plant. Common here in the islands, yet approaching extinction throughout the rest of the world, are species such as the striated caracara and the ruddy-headed goose, tame enough to make for some superb photo opportunities.

Included Shore Excursion – Bluff Cove Lagoon Penguin Safari



Don't miss this exciting excursion as we set off on a short drive on paved roads before we switch to Land Rover 4x4s for an off-road adventure to a privately owned wildlife haven.

Upon arrival at the Bluff Cove Penguin Rookery, our knowledgeable rangers will provide a briefing on the area and what to expect. Wander through the picturesque penguin colony, nestled beside a scenic lagoon and a pristine sandy beach occasionally visited by sea lions. Witness over 1,000 pairs of nesting Gentoo Penguins, along with Magellanic and Jackass penguins, and a small breeding colony of King Penguins. Keep an eye out for upland geese, ruddy-headed geese, Magellanic oystercatchers, Falkland's flightless steamer ducks, and other bird species that call this area home.

Try the locally favored Diddle-dee plant, made into jam for the "cream teas" served at the beachside Sea Cabbage Café. Enjoy a cup of tea, coffee, or hot chocolate, along with homebaked treats including scones with Diddle-dee jam, while soaking in the warmth of the Peat Stove and listening to live music.

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Explore the Bluff Cove museum, depicting life in the Falklands and showcasing the farm's history, the sugar wreck, the 1982 war between Britain and Argentina, and the abundant lagoon wildlife. Watch live demonstrations of spinning and felting with local wool used to make the Bluff Cove Tweed.

After ample free time to take photographs, stroll along the beach, explore the museum, and indulge in treats at the café, we'll return to the minibus via Land Rover 4x4s and head back to Stanley.

Day 10 DAY AT SEA - SCENIC CRUISING CAPE HORN

The Cape Horn passage is renowned as one of the most challenging ocean routes in the world, capturing the imagination of sailors for centuries. Surviving a journey around this point, where the Atlantic and Pacific oceans meet with force, was considered a remarkable achievement, earning sailors enduring respect and admiration.

Along this passage lies Tierra del Fuego, or the 'land of fire,' where Chile and Argentina converge at the bottom of the world. Early sailors named it for the fires they saw burning on shore, lit by the indigenous people who called this region home for some 8,000 years until the end of the 19th century.

Day 11 USHUAIA, ARGENTINA

Ushuaia, the world's southernmost city, is unlike any place you've ever visited. Surrounded by majestic mountain peaks on three sides and embraced by the mysterious Beagle Channel on the fourth, you'll have the opportunity to soak in every view, especially during the daylight cruise through Glacier Alley. Just outside of town lies the Tierra del Fuego National Park, a vast land of discovery and unimaginable beauty that extends into the rugged wilderness of Patagonia.



Included Private Shore Excursion – Tierra del Fuego National Park

Our journey begins in Ushuaia with a thirty-minute drive to the end of the famous Pan-American Highway. Here, we stand three thousand kilometers from Buenos Aires and eleven thousand from Alaska!

Tierra del Fuego National Park spans 63,000 hectares and boasts glorious mountain chains, rivers, hardwood forests, acid peat bogs, and rocky sea coasts. The combination of these diverse landscapes in a relatively small area is quite unique.

The park is a paradise for birdwatchers, home to Condors, Rayaditos, giant Black Carpenter birds, Southern Parrots, Thrushes, Fishing Martins, Flightless Steamer ducks, and forest birds. Huge beaver dams punctuate the small rivers, creating lakes that are havens for a large variety of peat bog plants and tender orchids.

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The Strait of Magellan is an oceanic passage which generally connects the Atlantic Ocean to the Pacific Ocean, situated in southern Chile and Argentina. The earliest European voyage from the Atlantic to the Pacific was Portuguese explorer Ferdinand Magellan, and his route, the Strait of Magellan, between the South American mainland and Tierra del Fuego is named for him. The Strait of Magellan is fully navigable and offers a glimpse into a very unique world in this water body classified as a semi-enclosed periantartic ecosystem.

Day 13 PUNTA ARENAS, CHILE

This picturesque town, set on rolling, wind scoured hills, is considered Chilean big sky country. Our local guide tells us of the tall Aonikenk or Tehuelches aboriginal people who were nomad and terrestrial hunters. It is said that their high stature and pronounced plantar footprint gave origin to the name Patagonia. On departing Punta Arenas this evening, the ship will sail the Cockburn Channel, the Beagle Channel and Glacier Alley. Make sure you are on deck as the scenery is quite dramatic!

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Day 12 DAY AT SEA: STRAIT OF MAGELLAN



Discover the city of Punta Arenas, capital of the Region of Magallanes and Chilean Antarctica, founded in 1848 and located on the shores of the Strait of Magellan. We will visit its main streets and avenues; the Cerro Mirador from where we will obtain a panoramic view of the city overlooking the Port, the Strait of Magellan, and Tierra del Fuego Island. We will continue our tour towards the Plaza de Armas and Municipal Cemetery before returning to the pier.

Day 14 DAY A SEA: COCKBURN CHANNEL

As you near the southern tip of South America, traveling along the Chilean or Pacific coast, you'll know that you're approaching the Cockburn (pronounced 'CO-burn') Channel when you see the twin rocks that guard its entrance. The channel flows between the Brecknock Peninsula (the westernmost edge of Isla Grande de Tierra del Fuego) and a number of islands, including Clarence Island with its irregular coastline of dramatic sounds that reach deep into its interior. The coastline here is rich in fjords and glaciers. The Pia Fjord is especially beautiful, as dozens of waterfalls cascade down the slopes into its waters. If you watch long enough, you may see huge chunks of ice calve off Pia Glacier and fall into the sea.

Day 16 PUERTO MONTT, CHILE

This charismatic town, in the style of its Bavarian settlers, features homes with steeply pitched roofs and elaborate balconies. Our adventure takes us to Petrohue Waterfalls and the 'City of Roses,' Puerto Varas.



Included Private Shore Excursion – Puerto Montt, Puerto Varas & Petrohue

Passing through the centre of the city with its typical square and the cathedral known as the region's oldest building, we stop at an observation point for a beautiful view of the city, Tenglo Island and the Tenglo Channel. Leaving Puerto Montt, we drive along the edge of the shores of Lago Llanquihue, Chile's second largest lake head towards Puerto Varas, the City of Roses. Reflections of the eternally snow-covered volcanoes Osorno and Calbuco are mirrored in the clear waters of the lake.

The costanera (coastal road) leads to Puerto Varas' main square with its gardens and historical monument. Travel north to Petrohue Waterfalls and the famous vacation retreat area. The impressive coned peak of the Osorno volcano rises out of the landscape to greet you. Enjoy the bewildering volcanic rock waterfall before returning to Puerto Montt.

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Moneda Palace. Ride the funicular to San Cristóbal Hill where you will enjpy panoramic views of the city.
