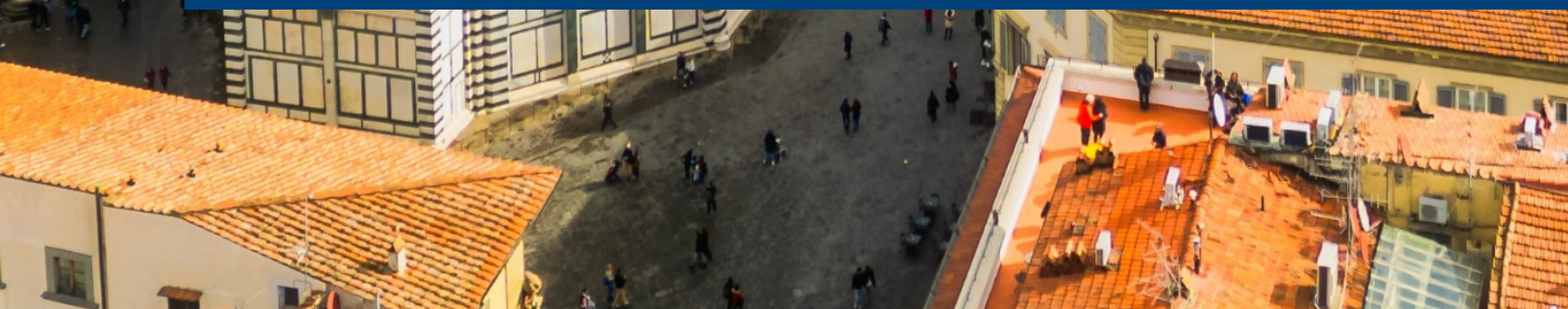

① Florence, Italy

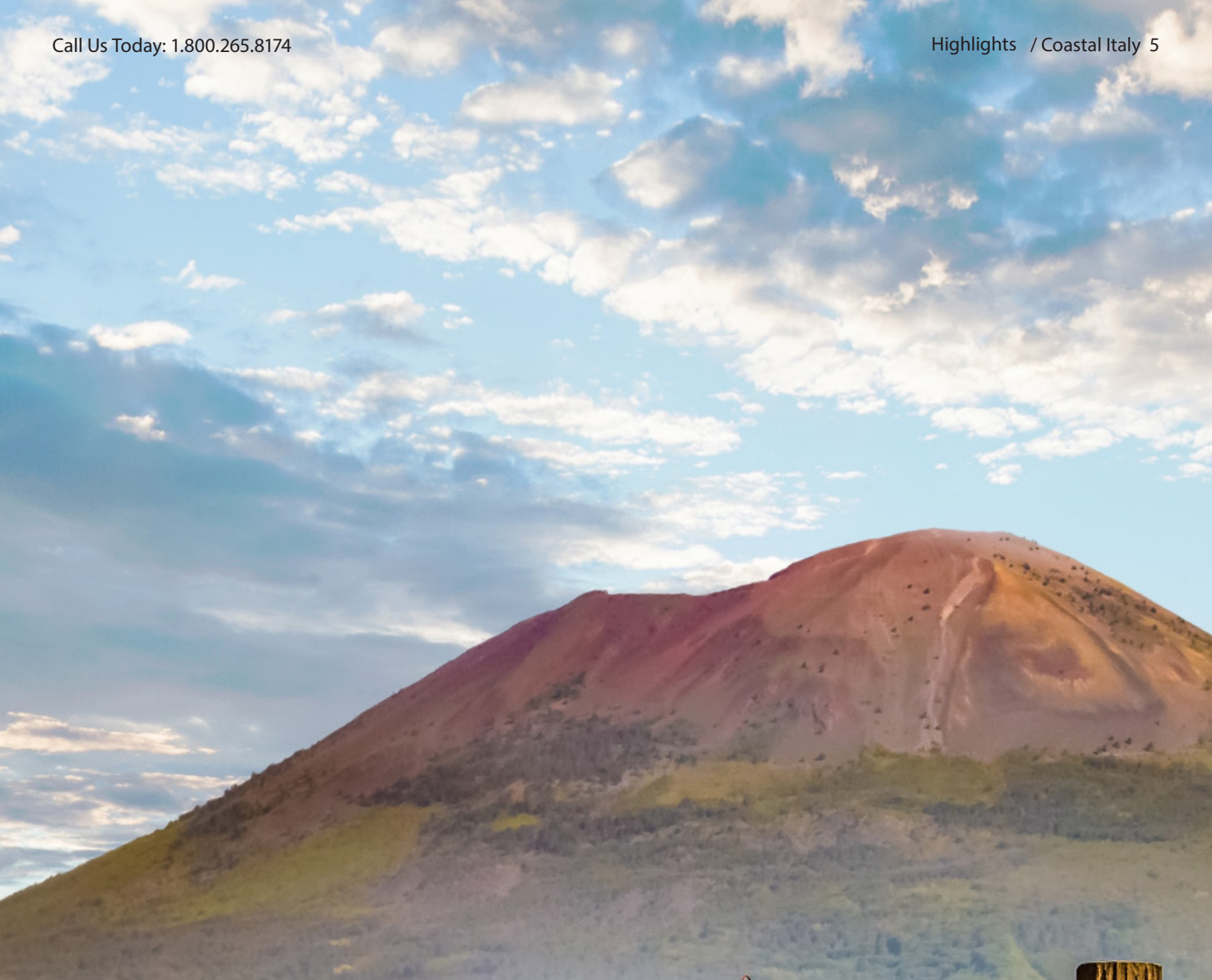

Day 3

FLORENCE, ITALY

The afternoon is yours to explore Florence at your leisure—perhaps visit the Uffizi Gallery or the grand Palazzo Pitti. In the evening, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant, savoring the rich flavors of the region.

Day 4

OLIVE OIL FARM & PISA, ITALY

Day 5

CHIANTI & SIENA, ITALY

Our day begins with a trip to the charming city of Siena, the cradle of Italian Gothic style. Explore the magnificent 13th-century Cathedral, with its stunning architecture and splendid polychrome marbles. In the 12th-century shell-shaped Piazza del Campo, admire the site of the famous Palio horserace, crowned by the imposing Palazzo Pubblico, a testament to Siena's independence and economic power.

After our visit, enjoy a tasting lunch at a nearby farm that produces Chianti wine and olive oil. This historic estate, once the residence of an ancient noble Sieneese family, offers breathtaking panoramic views of Siena. After a day of exploration, we'll transfer to Rome to get settled in for the next part of our journey.

Day 6

VATICAN CITY & ROME, ITALY

Day 9

POSITANO, ITALY

In the 1950s, the allure of Dolce Vita transformed Positano from a quaint fishing village into a glamorous retreat. Since 1997, the Amalfi Coast has been a UNESCO World Heritage site.

Begin with a scenic boat ride from Amalfi to Positano. Explore the village at your leisure, browsing over 200 boutiques known for their locally made cotton clothing. Afterward, meet your guide and return by boat to Amalfi. Enjoy free time to discover the village or relax before heading back to the ship.

Note: This tour involves walking on cobblestone streets, uphill paths, and steps. Please wear comfortable shoes, dress for the weather, and bring a hat, sunscreen, and water.

Day 12

LIPARI & STROMBOLI, ITALY

Please note: The excursion involves a 15-minute walk over cobblestone and uneven surfaces between the tender pier and the bus parking. Wear weather-appropriate clothes and comfortable walking shoes, and bring a hat and water.

Next, visit the Tenuta di Castellaro estate, where you'll tour the winery and its vineyards, followed by a wine tasting with local snacks. The afternoon will be spent sailing around the stunning island of Stromboli, where you'll witness its active volcano, famous for its dramatic, fiery eruptions visible from the sea.

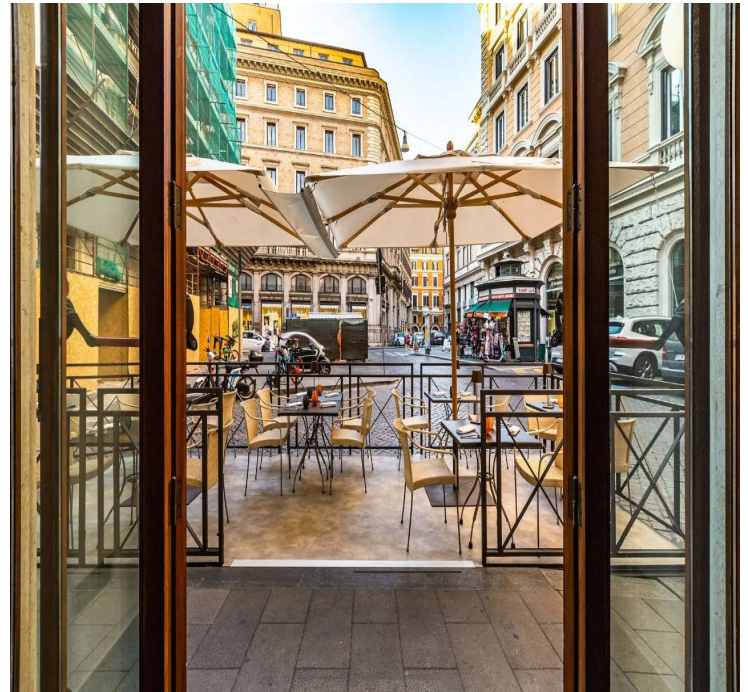
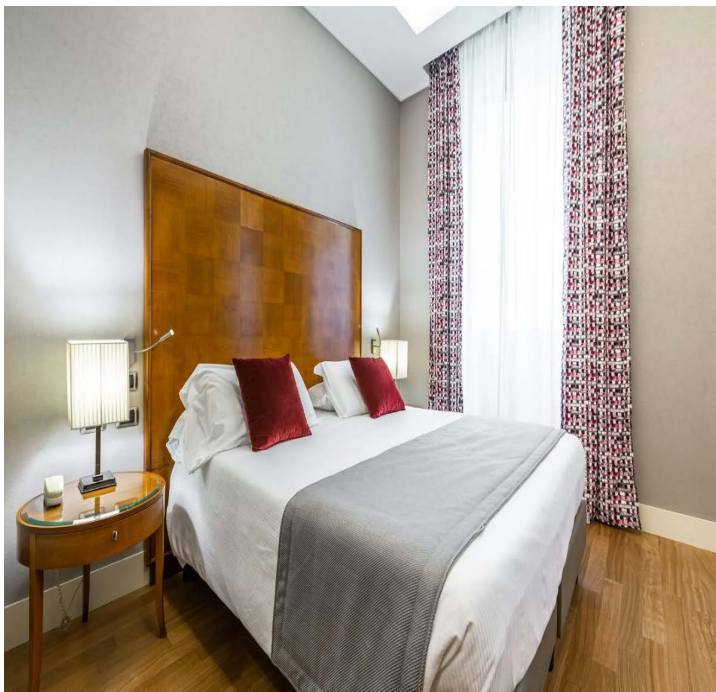


Day 4

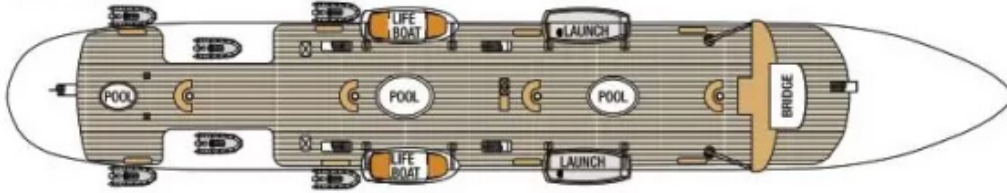
The expansive 19,000 square feet of open deck space, complete with three inviting swimming pools, provides a perfect setting for relaxation and stunning ocean views.



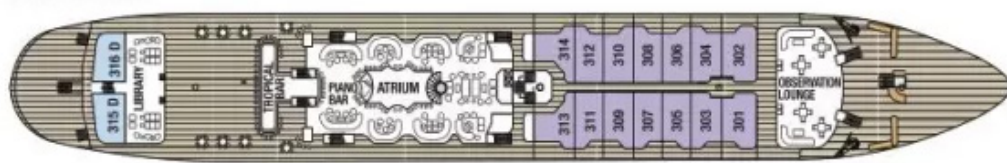

ROYAL CLIPPER DECKPLAN

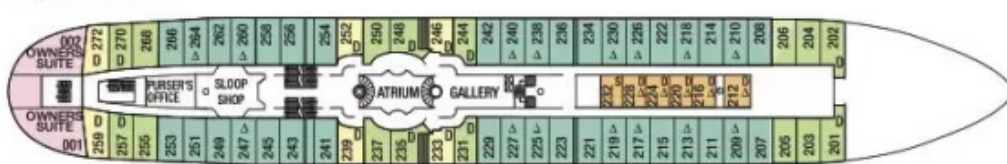

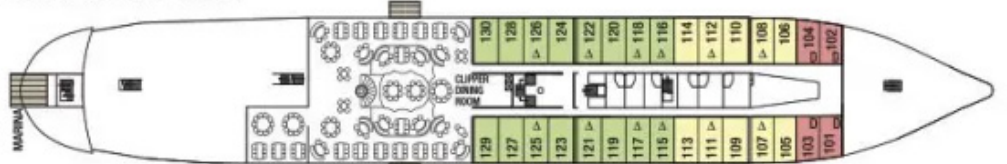
Main Deck
