Day 2

ARRIVE IN DUBROVNIK, CROATIA

Arrive in Dubrovnik and settle into your hotel before enjoying a welcome dinner with the group. This evening, relax at your leisure, with the option to take advantage of direct beach access, explore Dubrovnik's Medieval Old Town, or simply bask in the spectacular views of the Elaphiti Islands as you prepare for the journey ahead.

DUBROVNIK, CROATIA

Today, meet our local English-speaking guide who will lead us to Dubrovnik's historical center, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Explore its highlights with the group, then enjoy free time to discover more—whether walking the famous city walls or taking the cable car to Mount Srđ for breathtaking views. Experience firsthand why Dubrovnik is called the Pearl of the Adriatic.

CAVTAT AND ČILIPI, CROATIA

Today, we visit Cavtat, an ancient seaside town known as Epidaurus during its Greek colonization. This picturesque town, with its stunning coastlines and harmonious architecture, remains one of the Adriatic's most attractive destinations. After exploring Cavtat, we head to Čilipi village, the largest settlement in Konavle, where local traditions come to life. Discover the unique micro-urban unit around the Parish of St. Nicholas, surrounded by traditional stone houses.

Afterward, enjoy lunch at a restaurant along the river Ljuta and prepare to embark upon the luxurious MV Ambassador that awaits your arrival. Settle into the ship and enjoy the ammenities onboard before kicking off with a welcome dinner and set sail on the next adventure on our Journey.

...NUFS'I 'XCFST, CROATIA

Wake up to the sea breeze and enjoy a lovely breakfast onboard the MV ambassador before setting sail for the Elaphiti islands, renowned for their stunning beachs and crystal-clear waters. We will visit the Šipan island before continuing on our cruise to Slano.

Upon arrival, we will be greeted by a local guide and board a coach to Ston, known for its well-preserved medieval city walls. Experience Ston's renowned oysters with a visit to an oyster farm and a unique tasting at the source. Our ship will stay in Slano overnight.





MLJET NATIONAL PARK & KORČULA, CROATIA

Our morning cruise brings us to Mljet National Park, a haven of tranquility and natural beauty. Explore the park's Great and Small Lakes, visit the Islet of St. Mary with its 12th-century Benedictine Monastery, and take a refreshing swim in the heart of the park.

Return to the MS Ambassador for lunch before continuing toward the island of Korčula. Known as the birthplace of Marco Polo, Korčula invites you to explore its narrow, cobbled streets and rich history. Afterward, board a coach to visit local wine cellars and sample exquisite olive oil. This evening, enjoy a traditional "peka" dinner in the village of Žrnovo. This special dish, featuring lamb and veal cooked under an iron bell, offers an authentic taste of the region.

VIS, CROATIA

Our morning cruise will bring us to the island of Vis, the highlight of today's exploration, but not without a stop for a swim in the stunning Mediterranean. Vis is a pearl among Adriatic islands, untouched by tourism for many years. Its strategic location on the open sea preserved its pristine beauty, as it was a military zone.

Vis is now celebrated for its beautiful beaches, unspoiled nature, ecological agriculture, and well-preserved architecture. Embrace the island's charm with an afternoon tour, including a visit to the famous coastal town of Komiža. Enjoy a group dinner here before returning to the ship, docked in the town of Vis for the night.



HVAR & BIŠEVO BLUE CAVE, CROATIA

Our morning sail leads us to the Island of Biševo, famed for its enchanting Blue Cave. Accesible by boat if water levels permit, or by dive below sea level for the adventurous, we'll experience its captivating deep blue and shiny silver hues mystical blue depths for an unforgettable experience.

After a delightful onboard lunch, continue the journey through stunning bays and coves to Hvar, the sunniest island in Croatia. Hvar is celebrated as one of the country's premier tourist destinations and a hotspot for international jet-setters.

Immerse in the island's history and culture while strolling through its streets and discovering its century-old lavender farming tradition. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant before heading back to the ship, docked in the historical town for the night.

BOL & TROGIR, CROATIA

Our day begins with a morning departure, setting sail forBol, renowned for having Croatia's best beach for swimming, Zlatni Rat (the Golden Cape). Upon arrival, relax at a charming coffee shop, explore the town, or take a refreshing swim at the beach before returning to the ship for lunch.

SPLIT, CROATIA

ŠIBENIK & ZADAR, CROATIA



Anastasia's Cathedral, the largest in Dalmatia. This evening, enjoy relaxing at our luxurious 5-star coastal wellness hotel, known for its tranquil natural setting.

In the afternoon, we continue to Ljubljana, Slovenia, preparing for the final leg of our adventure.



IMPORTANT NOTE

This Journey is designed to be an **active tour** and will require more physicality than some of our others. It is important to note the following before reserving your spot:

Walking Requirements: Guests need to be able to walk 3-5 km unaided on uneven surfaces.

Stair Climbing: The ability to climb several flights of stairs is necessary.

Pedestrian Zones: Many European city centers have pedestrian zones where coaches are not permitted. The majority of tours on this Journey will be walking tours.

Meals in Local Restaurants: Several meals will be served in local restaurants, requiring guests to walk from the boat/hotel to the restaurants and back.

No Lift on the Boat: The MS Ambassador does not have a lift.

Rafting: When docked, the MS Ambassador may be rafted to other boats, requiring passage through them to get off.

Tendering Ashore: There may be times when the MS Ambassador is anchored, and the group is tendered ashore.






Day 11 FALKENSTEINER HOTEL & SPA, ZADAR




