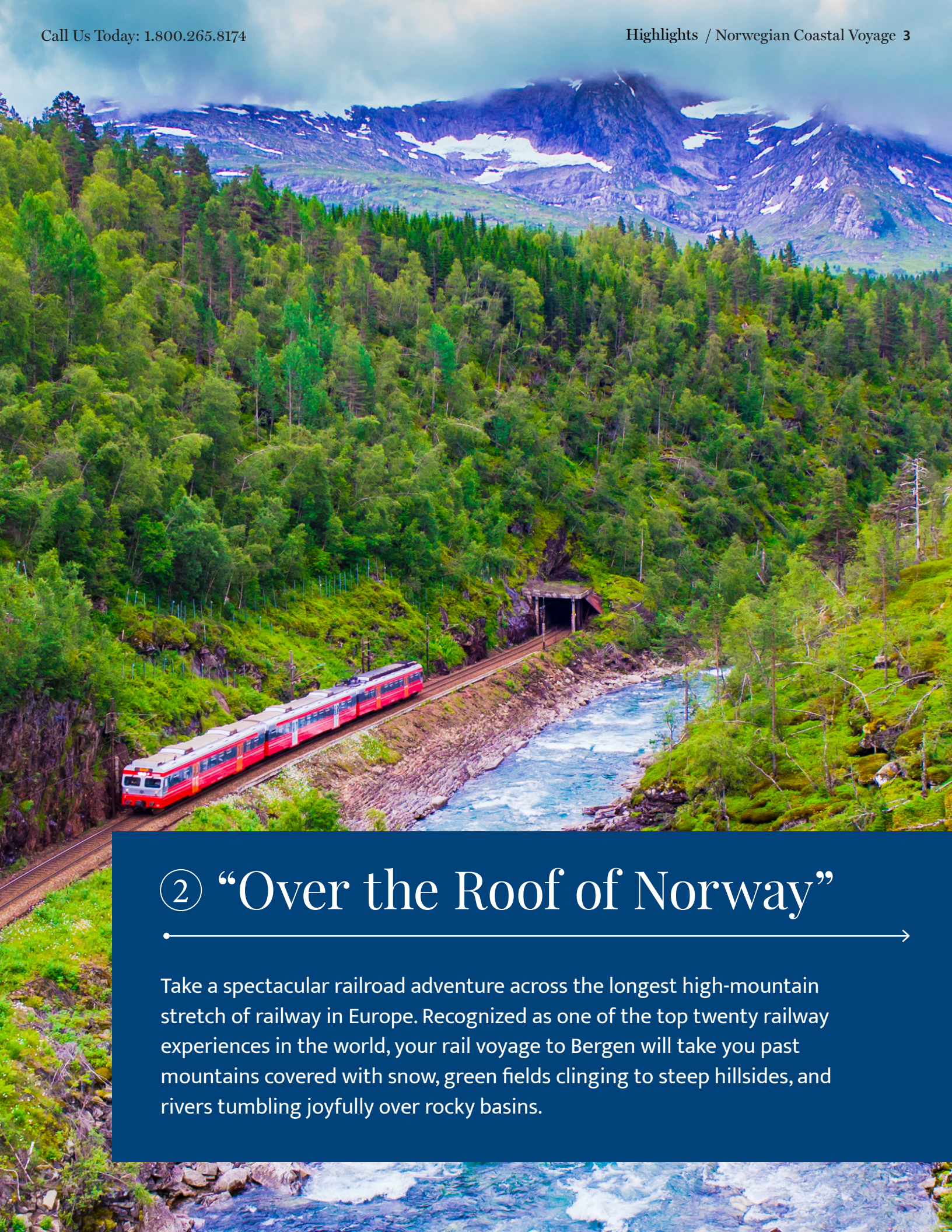

① Arctic Circle

An awe-inspiring and once in a lifetime experience, venture across one of the five major circles of latitude that mark the Earth. Crossing the magical Arctic Circle is considered to be one of the greatest and unmissable life experiences. Make the experience even more memorable by celebrating in an authentic Arctic Circle Crossing Ceremony.



② “Over the Roof of Norway”

Take a spectacular railroad adventure across the longest high-mountain stretch of railway in Europe. Recognized as one of the top twenty railway experiences in the world, your rail voyage to Bergen will take you past mountains covered with snow, green fields clinging to steep hillsides, and rivers tumbling joyfully over rocky basins.



③ Lofoten Islands

The Lofoten Islands are a feast for the senses. Feel a rush of emotion as you gaze at the endless mountains, colourful green valleys, brightly-coloured houses, and tranquil rippling waters. While in Lofoten, we'll enjoy a concert in an old Herring Oil tank, and visit the Lofoten Aquarium.



④ The “Atlantic Road”

A long ribbon, draped across the rocks and islets connecting Norway’s mainland to the island of Averøy, the “Atlantic Road” is one of the most scenic drives in the world. Drive along this stunning feat of engineering for magnificent views as you drive down the gently winding road and across bridges jutting out over the sea.

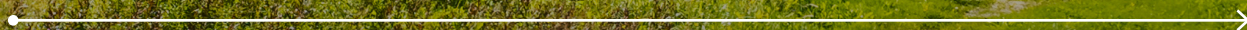


⑤ Havila Castor

OSLO

TOURING OSLO

Day 4

RAIL JOURNEY TO BERGEN

Today, we board the train and travel 'Over the Roof of Norway,' to Bergen. On arrival in Bergen, we are introduced to this beautiful city by our local guide before we board the Havila Castor, your home for the next eleven days. Day 5

SCENIC CRUISING GEIRANGERFJORD

Before roads were put in place, Geiranger was fairly isolated and only accessible by boat. Perhaps the best way to see the Geirangerfjord is by this traditional mode of travel. As you cruise through the deep blue water surrounded by magnificent mountains, you'll get to marvel at the famous waterfalls such as the "Seven Sisters" and view historic seters (mountain farms) perched high on the hilltops.

Day 6

TRONDHEIM

Founded in 997 and capital of Norway during the Viking Age, Trondheim is steeped in history and culture. The colourful houses, quaint waterways and charming cobbled streets make this town picture-perfect!

Included Private Excursion – Experiencing Trondheim

We see the remarkable music history at the Ringve Museum, where local music students play for us. We continue our exploration to Norway's largest medieval church, Nidaros Cathedral, the site of the coronation of the kings of Norway and the home of the crown jewels.

Havila Tradition – Arctic Circle Competition

Sometime tomorrow morning, the Havila Castor will cross the Arctic Circle. Participate in the ship-wide competition by placing a guess of what time that will happen.

Day 7

CROSSING THE ARCTIC CIRCLE

Day 8

TROMSØ

In Tromsø, our guide takes us to the Arctic Cathedral, a beautiful and modern church inspired by the local Norwegian faith and nature. Tromsø is affectionately known as the Arctic capital. Surrounded by majestic mountains, scenic fjords and picturesque islands, Tromsø's many attractions offer history, daring architecture, wildlife, science, culture and impressive vistas.

Included Private Excursion – Tromsø, the Arctic Cathedral and Cable Car

We venture off to explore this fascinating university city affectionately called 'The Paris of the North.' Visit the Arctic Cathedral with its magnificent stained-glass window, and a visit to the Polar Museum which preserves and conveys stories related to the history of Tromsø and the Arctic.

UNIQUE CONCERT & LOFOTEN AQUARIUM

In Svolvær, our overland Journey continues through the stunning wall of mountains that is Lofoten. This is an evening to remember and includes a visit to the Lofoten Aquarium.

DAY AT SEA: THE ARCTIC CIRCLE

We return to the ship in Molde, well known for its unspoiled views of the Alps of Romsdalen.

We bid Norway 'avskjed', and make our way to the airport for our flights home. Enjoy our private car to your home.

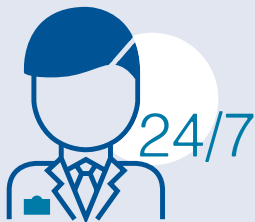
